



Configuring Your Internet Connection In Your Study Bedroom

Please follow the instructions below to enable you to access the internet.

1. Plug modem cable into adapter already plugged into the socket situated by the work space under the window**.
2. Switch laptop on.
3. When Windows has loaded up right click once on Internet Explorer (*Windows 98 or 2000*). If you are using Windows XP, Click on the start button, right click Internet Explorer, select internet properties – move to step 5.
4. At the bottom of the menu that has appeared, left click once on properties.
5. At the top of the Internet Properties box there are several tabs, one of which has the word connections in it, left click once on this tab.
6. Left click once on your Internet service Provider (ISP) this should have the word default in brackets next to it.
7. Left click once on the settings button.
8. Left Click on the Properties button that is next to the user name box.
9. In the box that titled Phone Number add a 9 to the beginning of the number already typed in there. Do *not* select an area code from the box on the left of this as it will not work when dialling, make sure the *whole* number including area code is in the right hand box.
10. When you have inserted the 9 into the beginning of the number left click once on OK
11. Left click on all OK buttons until you are back to the desk top screen.
12. Double left click on the Internet Explorer icon to launch the dialler program.

13. If prompted enter your dial up password in the box and left click on connect button.

****NB** If the cable that connects the laptop to the wall socket does not have a standard phone plug but a smaller square shaped plug, then this will plug directly into the socket without the need for the adapter. Remove the adapter and plug the cable into the socket.
